Bangladesh Air Force (BAF) and Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh (CAAB) are going to jointly organize “**International Flight Safety Seminar-2021 (IFSS-2021)**” at Dhaka, Bangladesh. The seminar was scheduled to be held from 18-20 October 2021. Due to the worsening situation of COVID-19 pandemic all around the world including Bangladesh IFSS-2021 is rescheduled to be held from 15-17 February 2022. The seminar is aimed at sharing knowledge, experience and good practices in the field of flight safety by the professionals of military and civil alike from both home and abroad including the Maintenance & Repair Organizations (MROs).

The theme of IFSS-2021 is “**Promoting Flight Safety by Embracing Technological Advancements**”. The advancements of technology, digitalization, and use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the field of operation and maintenance, have enabled aircraft to go faster and further with increased capabilities. Such technological progression is always associated with inherent safety challenges. The way out lies in the technological solutions based on higher data analysis capability, prompt & accurate fault detection, and more interactive & inclusive safety programmer management. IFSS-2021 aims at knowledge and experience sharing by different stakeholders from across the globe in addressing the safety challenges capitalizing technological advancements.
